4 ON 4 SUMMER LEAGUE PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a player in the Quest Hockey 4 on 4 Summer League, I agree to abide by and follow the Quest Hockey Player Code of Conduct below:

No swearing or abusive language on the bench, in the rink, or at any team function.

No lashing out at any official no matter what the call is.

Each player shall support and respect their teammates and opponents at all times. No player shall tease, ridicule, put down or make fun of any players on their team or the opposing team, at any time.

Each player shall conduct themselves in a befitting manner at all times during all team functions and while at the Ice Castle Arena.

The following behavior is strictly prohibited in the locker rooms:

Running, horseplay or hockey boxing

Foul or vulgar language

Throwing of snow/ice from skates, used tape, equipment or personal belongings

Misuse of lavatory facilities

Failure to keep locker rooms free from debris including used hockey tape, wrappers, cups etc.

Pounding, kicking or any misuse of lockers or benches or other locker room fixtures

Behavior that demonstrates a lack of respect for teammates, parents and others.

Behavior that demonstrates a lack of respect for the personal belongings of others.

By stepping on the ice for the Quest Hockey 4 on 4 Summer League you acknowledge that you have read and agree to abide by the Quest Hockey Player Code of Conduct. Violation of this Code of Conduct may result in loss of ice-time, suspension for part of or all of a game, or ejection from the League.
